


# REMINDER OF GOOD PRACTICES FOR SCIENTIFIC PUBLICATIONS

You are asked to:

- write your contact details and acknowledgments in publications according to the IHPE charter (pdf),
- have your manuscripts proofread by Anne before submission,
- select journals from quartile 1 (<u>excel list</u> of journals in the fields in which IHPE publishes) rather than a high impact factor,
- notify Anne of the publication for deposit of notice and manuscript on the open archive platform <u>HAL</u> within the framework of IHPE's <u>Open Science policy</u>
